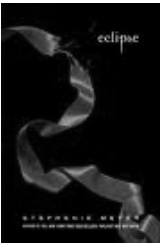

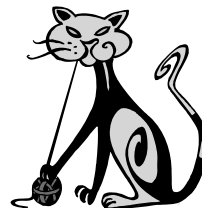
### Romania's Famous Exports from Food to Vampires

### Knit Wits Teen Knitters

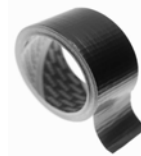
Open to experienced and new knitters. Come to the young adult area between 4 and 6 p.m. on Wednesdays. Use our materials or bring your own.
