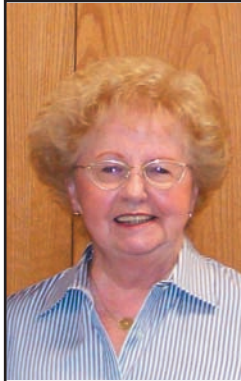

**Notes From the Library Manager**

Hello, *Friends!*

I'd like to talk to you about *Numbers*—



The first is North Port Library Hours. On October 5, 2009, we will be instituting new hours. We're not gaining hours; we're not losing hours. We're adjusting the hours to better suit the needs of those using the Library. Every adjustment we made was made with the Library user in mind.

The first change is that we're opening at 10 instead of 9:30. In fact, every library in Sarasota County will now open at 10 AM Monday through Saturday. This consistency should eliminate any confusion about which library opens when. Whether you're going to Jacaranda, Venice, North Port or Selby Library, you'll know it's opening at 10 AM Monday through Saturday.

The next change is that we're closing at 5 instead of 3:30 on Fridays and Saturdays. This allows students and others more time to get to the Library in the afternoon. So, any days that we're NOT open in the evening, we'll close at 5. Again, this is true of any library in Sarasota County. If they're not open late that day, they close at 5. More consistency to eliminate confusion about who's open when.

Lastly we're shifting which nights we stay open late. Starting October 5, North Port Library will be open until 8:00 on Tuesday and WEDNESDAY instead of Tuesday and Thursday. We changed our second late night to Wednesday based on community surveys which stated more people could and would come to the Library on Wednesday evenings than any other day of the week and very few preferred Thursday.

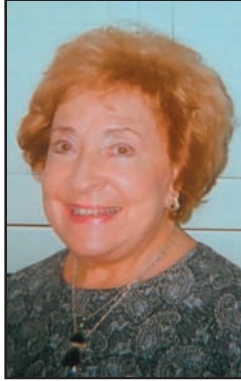
To summarize, here are the new North Port Library hours starting October 5.

- Wednesday: 10 AM to 8 PM
- Thursday: 10 AM to 5 PM
- Friday: 10 AM to 5 PM
- Saturday: 10 AM to 5 PM.

We always need Volunteers to work in the Bookstore. Just leave your name and phone number with one of our Volunteers and I will contact you with the particulars.

Finally, allow me to thank all of you who have supported our efforts with your book donations and with your purchases. We currently have 25 Volunteers and they appreciate being able to service you in the Bookstore.

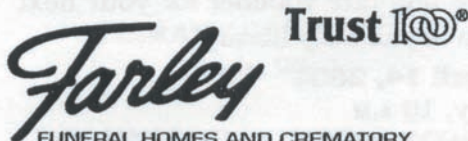
